This Deed made the seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy four between David McCracken and Mary M his wife of the first part and Charles McCracken of the second part. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said parties of the first part do grant unto the said party of the second part the following described property that is to say -

A certain tract of land in Liberty District Marshall County West Virginia and lying on the waters of south fork of Big Grave Creek above the town of Cameron and bounded as follows - Beginning at an Elm corner to Edward Denny Thence west with line of Chas McCracken said party of the second part to a stake at old grave yard thence S 16 1/2° E to pole to a maple and red oak thence S 55° E W 30° pl to a stake at B. & O. Rail Road thence with the meanders of said Rail Road west to a stake opposite to the corner of the land of John McCracken where his land corners on said Rail Road thence a straight line from said Rail Road to a sycamore tree near the creek on the County road near where the road forks thence with the meandering of the County road leading up to the state line in the direction of the south fork of Grave Creek to a stake at Roberts Andersons thence with the line of Edward Denny south to the place of beginning containing twenty acres (20) or there more or less it being a part of one hundred and twenty acres of land that was conveyed by Edward Stricklin wife to said party of the first part by Deed dated March 25th 1859 and of record in Marshall County West Virginia in Book 14 - Folio 257 -

And the said David McCracken & Mary M his wife do hereby covenant with the said party of the said party of the second part that they will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed

 between Joseph Thompson of Sand Hill Dist Marshall
 County West Virginia of the first part and Thomas
 Jefferson Winters of the same Dist County & state of the second part
 witnesses that in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first
 part doth grant unto the said party of the second part, the following
 described property that is to say -

A certain tract or parcel of land lying in Sand Hill District
 Marshall County West Virginia and bounded as follows -

Beginning at the forks of the old Washington road by Mary
 Marsh's thence along said Washington road 48 poles to a stone thence
 west 31 poles to a stake thence West 4 poles to a Beech stump thence S
 40 poles to a stone thence S.E. 19 poles to the beginning, containing 14
 acs more or less

And the said Joseph Thompson doth hereby covenant with the said
 party of the second part that he will warrant Generally the property
