McCracken I give devise and bequeath all my estate real and personal excepting therefrom Twelve hundred and fifty \$1250.00 Dollars which I reserve as and for my own and separate estate, said \$1250.00 to be paid as I may hereafter direct payable at the death of my husband, I appoint W.H. LOPER executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have signed and sealed and published and declared this instrument as and for my last will and testament at Gameron Marshall county west Virginia this the 16th day of April 1909.

And W. H. Loper, the executor named in said will having presented to the court a paper writing showing that he declined and refused to qualify and act as such executor, W. C. McCracken, the husband of the said Flora A. McCracken, deceased, was duly appointed administrator with the will annexed, of said estate, and letters of administration duly awarded him.

The said W. C. McCracken appeared and took the oath required by law and together with T. C. Pipes, his surety, acknowledged a bond in the penal sum of Five Hundred Dollars conditioned according to law.

Harry Elbin, Harvey Hicks and R. A. Startzman are appointed to appraise the said estate.
