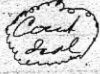

This Deed made the sixth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between Isaac M. Cracken and Elizabeth his wife of the first part, and S. P. Young Treasurer of the West Pennsylvania Eldership of the Church of God and his Successor in office of the second part. Witnesseth: That in Consideration of the sum of ten Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said parties of the first part do grant unto the said party of the second part the following described property that is to say: a Lot of ground Situated on the Road leading up the South fork of Grave Creek to the State line above Cameron and in the forks of said road and the road leading across to the North fork of grave creek on the land of Isaac M. Cracken, said party of the first part, in Cameron District Marshall County West Virginia and bounded as follows: Beginning at a Stone in Edge of the forks of the County Road: thence N 10 W 3/4 poles to a Stake: thence S 75 W 5/8 poles to a Stake: thence S 15 E 5/8 poles to the edge of County Road: thence with same A S E @ 6 1/2 poles to the place of Beginning containing one third of an acre or the same more or less: said Lot having a Meeting House erected thereon now it is therefore agreed and understood that should said Church of God become extinct as a denomination the property shall fall back to said party of the first part Isaac M. Cracken or his Successor whosoever he may convey said land to adjoining said lot, and said Church of God shall not convey to any other in their time said property nor use it except as a place of worship. And the said parties of the first part do hereby Covenant with the said party of the second part that they will warrant & generally the property, hereby conveyed Witness the following signatures and Seals.

This Deed made the tenth day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy five Between Hannah Woodruff Executrix of E. B. Woodruff Deceased, of the first part, and Catherine Jackson of the second part, Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said party of the first part do grant unto the said party of the second part the following described property: that is to say: a piece of ground in Meade District and bounded as follows: Beginning at a black oak corner to W. H. Woodruff thence West 29 poles to a stone corner to J. M. White thence North 6th & 35 to a stone on J. R. Bice's line thence with the same East 37 poles to a stone thence South 5th & 13 poles to a road thence East 1 pole to W. H. Woodruff's line thence with the same S 5th & 40 poles to the place of Beginning containing Eight and one half acres more or less it being a Sale by the bulk or piece and not by the acre and the Galt.
