ON THIS 5 day of July, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety

personally appeared before me, Carl of the County court, a Court

of Record in and for the County and State aforesaid, Noah Barcus

aged 78 years, resident of the City of Moundsville

County of Marshall, State of West Va, who, being duly

sworn according to law, declares that he is the father of Jonathan Barcus

who enlisted under the name of Jonathan Barcus, at

Wheeling W Va, on the 1st day of July, 1861

in I 3rd Regt W Va, Inf, Vol.

(Here state rank, company, and regiment in Military service, or vessel, if Navy.)

afterward 6 W Va, Cavalry, Vol. 1

in the War of the Rebellion, who died at near Rock Port W Va, on the

day of March, 1870, from the effects of Chronic

diarrhoea and rheumatism,

incurred at Buchanan W Va, on the Dec. day of 1861

That said son left neither widow, nor child under sixteen years of age, surviving. That declarant was married to the

mother of said son on the 17 day of May, 1833, at

Bowman Marshalls W Va., by Rev. James Jefferson

and that she died on the middle day of June, 1873, at

near Moundsville W Va. That he is without other PRESENT means of support than

his own manual labor, or the contributions of others not legally bound for his support. That he has applied

for a pension, the number of his application being 364611. That he makes this declaration for the purpose

of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints
