LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF GEORGE W. JOHNSON

I, George W. Johnson, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, and direct the payment of all my just debts.

I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Julia E. Johnson, all the personal property of which I may die seized. I also give to her for her use as long as she may live and remains my widow the home property No. 2334 Market st. occupying the south 1/3 of lot No. 122 in Chapline and Eoffs addition to the city of Wheeling, at her death the aforesaid home property shall be sold, and the proceeds of said

sale shall be distributed as follows: each of my five oldest children, to-wit; Robert H., Louis B., Harris, Isabelle and George B. Johnson shall receive the sum of twenty-five dollars (25.00), and the remainder shall be equally divided between Earl and Elmer Johnson, my two youngest children. In the event that my wife Julia E. Johnson should again marry, I direct that the home property, above referred to, shall be sold, and the proceeds of such sale, after deducting my wife's dower interest, shall be distributed in the same ratio and manner as though my wife had remained my widow until her death, to-wit: 25.00 to each of my 5 oldest children, and the balance to be equally divided between my 2 youngest children.

Footnote on a vanishing Wheeling landmark, from a former South Wheeling resident who remembers days gone by;

To complete U. S. 250 North, the bulldozers have cut a wide gash where the house stood, and the kids who gathered there are grandparents. But the memory of a rich experience lives on.

In the early 1930's Mr. Johnson came out the front door of his home at 2344 Wilson St. every summer Sunday morning with the News-Register in hand. He had a great shock of White hair and a ruddy, friendly face. He wore a dress shirt with detachable celluloid collar, detached, wide olive colored suspenders, black trousers, and highly polished black shoes.

Mr. Johnson sat down on the wide gray steps of his house to study the news. Soon his children, Francis and Marie, Laughlin, Baron and Kelsey, joined him; Then kids from all over the neighborhood gathered on the steps.

They waited patiently for Mr. Johnson to get to the comics, which he read to them. Radio's Uncle Don was a rank amateur compared with Mr. Johnson, for only he could pack so much drama in Dick Tracy's stalking "The Blank." Who better than Mr. Johnson could mimic the German accent of the Katzenjammer kids as they stole Mama's prize pies and tormented the Captain?

But the best was to hear Mr. Johnson laugh at these antics. He would slap his thigh and laugh jovially, and all the kids joined in and forgot for an hour the deprivation of those days.

POLICE PATROLMAN FOUND DEAD AT CENTRAL STATION

Patrolman Jay Stimmel, 46, was found shot to death last night in the basement of Central Police Station. His shocked colleagues said Stimmel apparently shot himself.

They ruled out possibilities someone shot him but also said there is a small chance the shooting was accidental. Stimmel's .38-caliber service revolver was found near the body.

Stimmel, of 4218 Archwood Ave. SW, a 25-year veteran, returned to the station around 10:40 p.m. after investigating a downtown bookstore robbery, police said. His partner, Patrolman John Paul, was phoning information to the police records center and Stimmel told Paul he would meet him at their cruiser.

Stimmel's body was found at 10:48 p.m., 12 minutes before he was to go off duty. He is survived by his wife and two children.

POLICEMAN SHOT, CORONER TO RULE

The coroner's office is expected to rule today on the death of Cleveland Patrolman Jay Stimmel, whose body was found in the basement of Central Police Station last night.

Stimmel had been shot once in the head. His .38-caliber service revolver was found near his body.

Stimmel, 46, a 25-year veteran of the force, had returned to the station about 10:40 last night after investigating a downtown bookstore burglary. His body was found at 10:48 p.m. only 20 feet from the basement security office. He was due to go off duty at 11 p.m.

His partner, Patrolman John Paul said the two had returned to the station to fill out their report. He said Stimmel told him he had to return to their cruiser for something.
