**Private Harry W. Davis.**

Harry W. Davis, well known and popular young man, passed away in Camp Meade, Md., Saturday, according to a message received by his mother, Mrs. Augusta Cook, of 1216 McCulloch street. Death was caused by pneumonia, superinduced by Spanish influenza. He leaves besides his mother, a step-father, Edward Cook, and several brother and sisters, including one brother who is in the army. Private Lewis was a stogmaker. He entrained from here for camp last September. Funeral arrangements will be completed upon arrival of the body, which is expected today.
