I, Mike Summit, aged 26 years,
occupation R. R. Laborer, do declare on oath that my personal
description is: Color white, complexion dark, height 5 feet 2 1/2 inches,
weight 120 pounds, color of hair black, color of eyes brown,
other visible distinctive marks none.

I was born in Bathum, Mt. Lebanon, Syria,
on the 15th day of June, anno Domini 1890; I now reside
at 2216 Main Street Wheeling, W. Va.

I emigrated to the United States of America from Genere, France,
on the vessel forget name of vessel; my last
foreign residence was Bathum, Syria.

I am not married.
It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign
prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Mohmed V,
Emperor of the Ottomans, of whom I am now a subject;

I arrived at the port of New York, in the
State of New York, on or about the 13th day
of May, anno Domini 1900; I am not an anarchist; I am not a
polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith
to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside therein;
