

HENRY HARRY GILMORE

Private - M. G. Company, 150th Infantry (See Veterans' Bureau Index Card)

Died of Meningitis on December 25, 1917

Henry Harry Gilmore, born on April 22, 1895 in Clarington, Monroe County, Ohio, was the son of Ezra Gilmore and Louisa Smith, both born in Ohio.

In the 1910 census of Salem, Monroe County, Ohio, Ezra, a farmer and his wife had the following children at home: Amy, 22, Martin, 20, Eva, 18, Henry, 15, William, 13, James, 11, Elsie, 7, Reece, 4, and Glen, 1.

When Henry Harry Gilmore registered for the World War I Draft, he was a resident of Glenwood Heights, Wheeling, Ohio County, West Virginia.
