I nave to advise you that from the papers in the Revolutionary War possion claim width, it appears that Jeremich Thillans was born in February 1761, in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. While residing in Cumberland (Inter, -Pranklin) County, Pennsylvania, he volunteered in 1776 and served eight months as a private under Ceptain John McGhaland in General Veinteen's Expectition against the Indians. We volunteered in March 1760 or 1761 and served six months as an Indian Spy under Lieuteant Taxes Marshill. We again emisted in the Spring of 1782 and served one month under Captain John Muston.

Ho was allowed pension on his application executed September 18, 1832, while living in Tyler County, Virginia, and he died February 6, 1845.

He married in Onto County, Virginia, June 7,1798, Mary Jean't, or Jean't, and she was allowed pension on her application executed November 22,1850, while residing in

Wetsel County, Virginia, aged seventy-two years. The was living in Campbell gounty, Kentucky, in 1869.

It is not stated whether they had any children.


