Born: 1753

Died: 1838

Buried in Greer Cemetery, Mason Co., WV

Fought at the Battle of Point Pleasant and Kings Mountain



Side note: Death date on headstone installed by the DAR is incorrect - per Mason County Circuit Court records John Greer died intestate in 1838

Major John (Jack) Greer, Drummer boy in War of 1812

Born: 3 Apr. 1840 Jackson Co., VA/WV

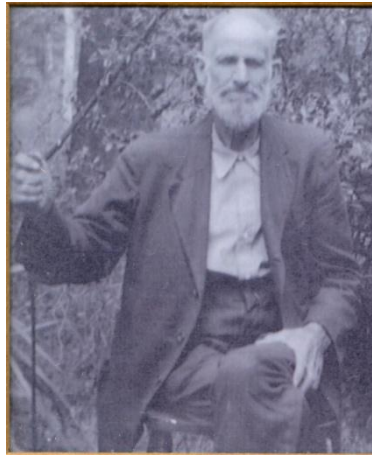

Born: 25 Feb 1844 Jackson Co., WV

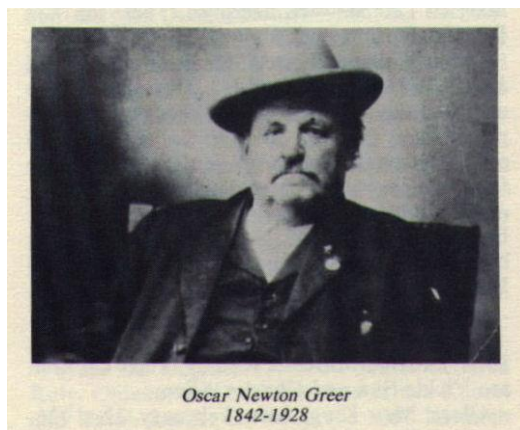
Died: 11 Jun 1928 Mason Co., WV

Buried in Greer Cemetery, Mason Co., WV

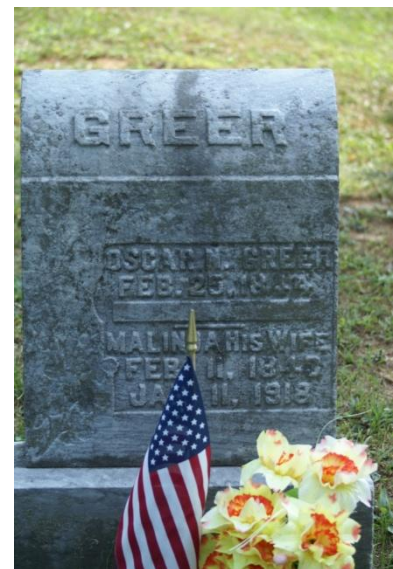
